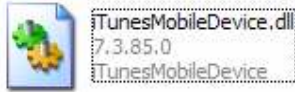


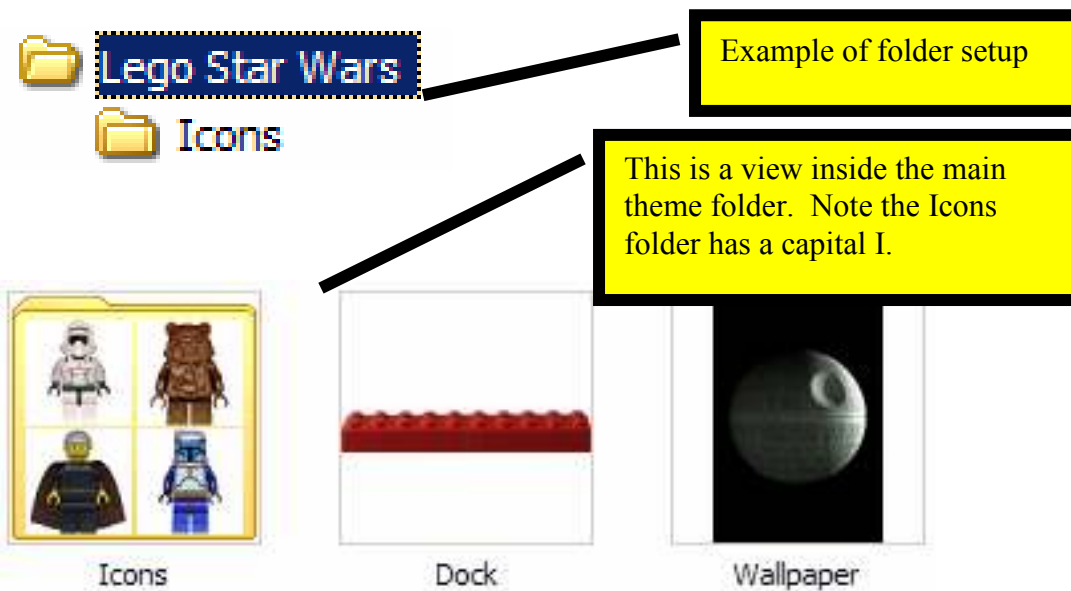
Uploading Themes with iPhoneBrowser

Open iPhoneBrowser with your iPhone plugged in. If you get an error complaining about iTunesMobileDevice.dll, just download it from MMi or Google it.



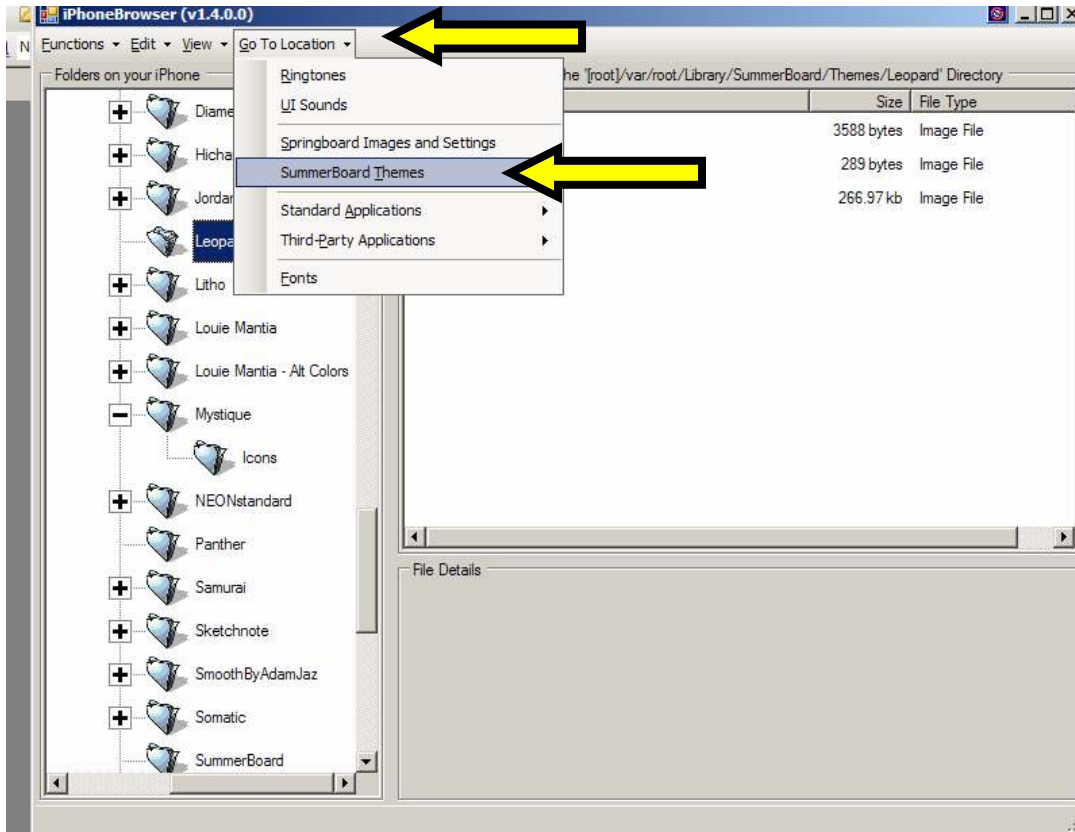
Before you start uploading your new theme make sure your new theme is in the following format:

- Theme folder
 - **Dock.png**
(The theme may or may not have a dock)
 - **Wallpaper.png**
(The theme may or may not have a wallpaper)
 - Icons folder
 - Icons

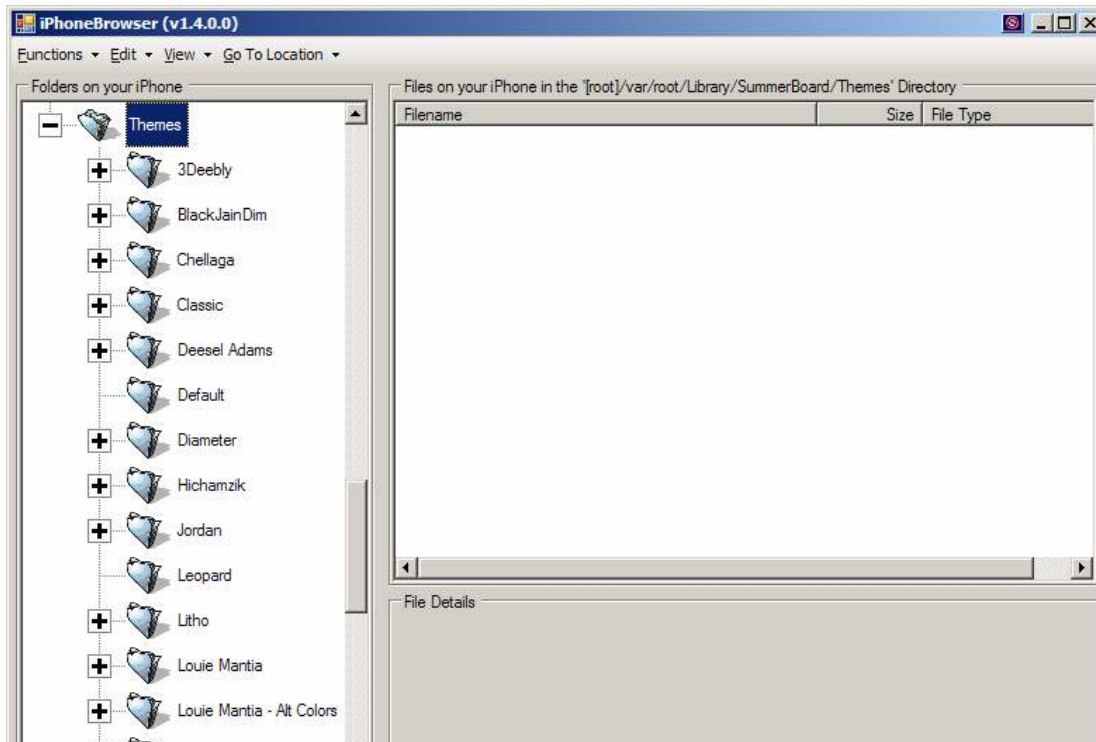


- Now that you verified your folder setup go to iPhoneBrowser.

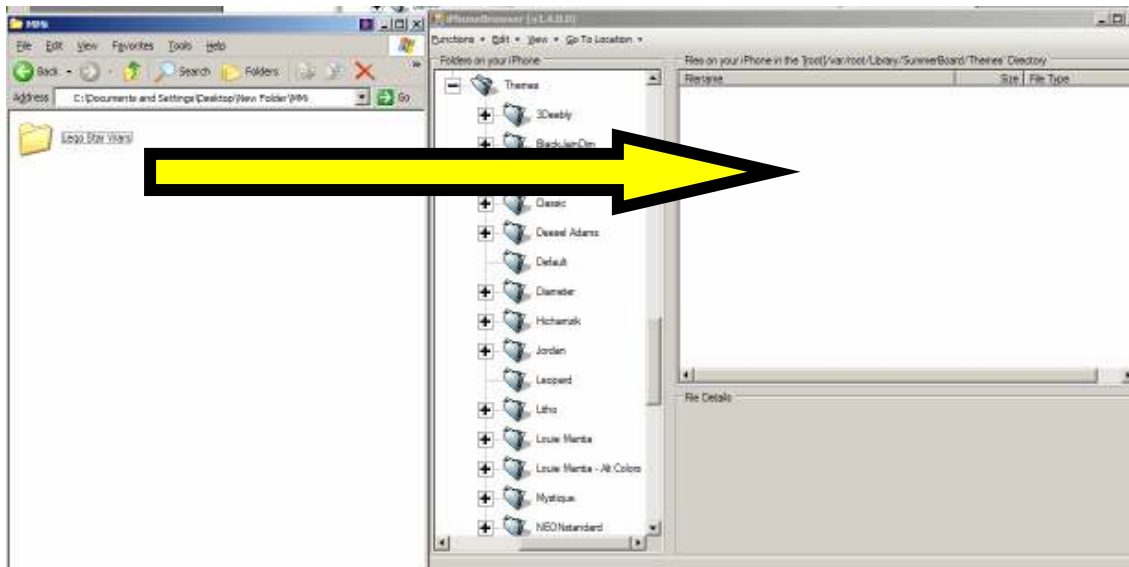
In iPhoneBrowser, click the 'Go To Location' button to get the dropdown.



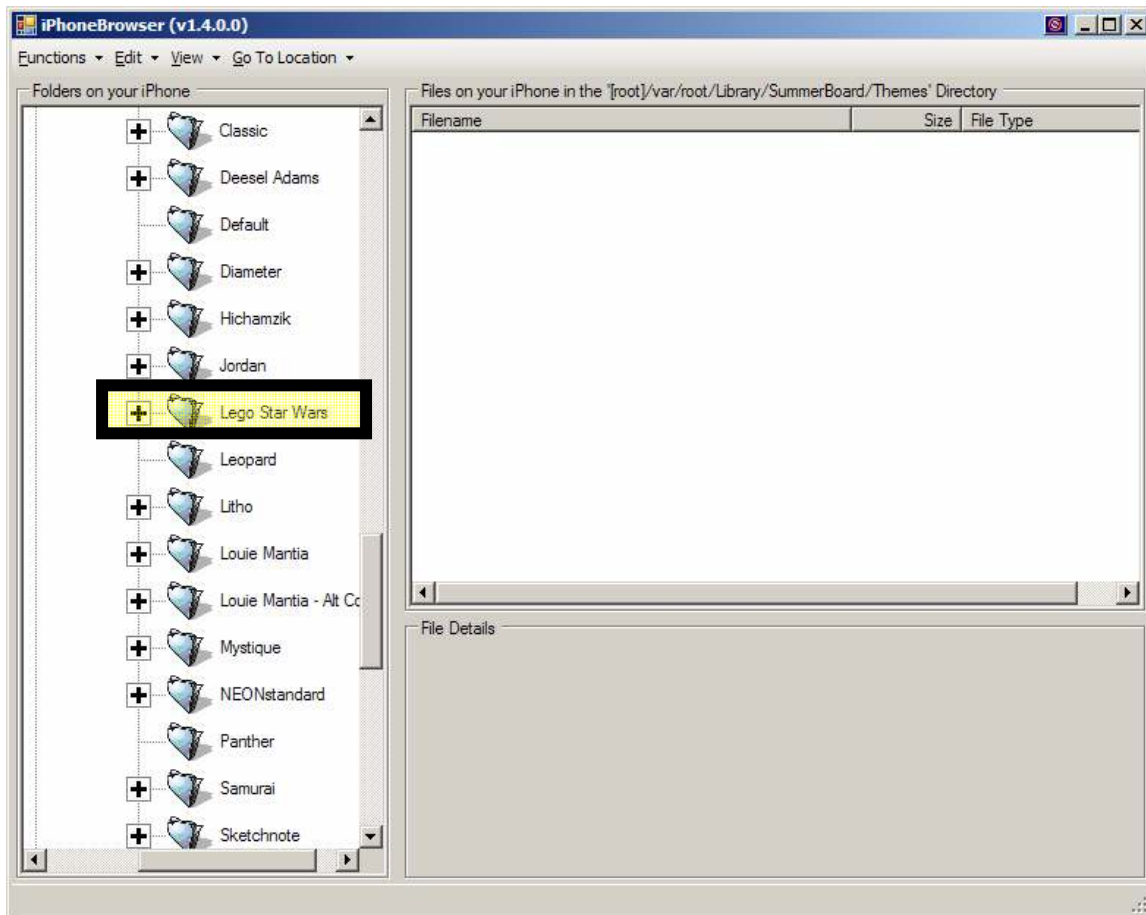
Once you click SummerBoard Themes you will go to location of all your themes.



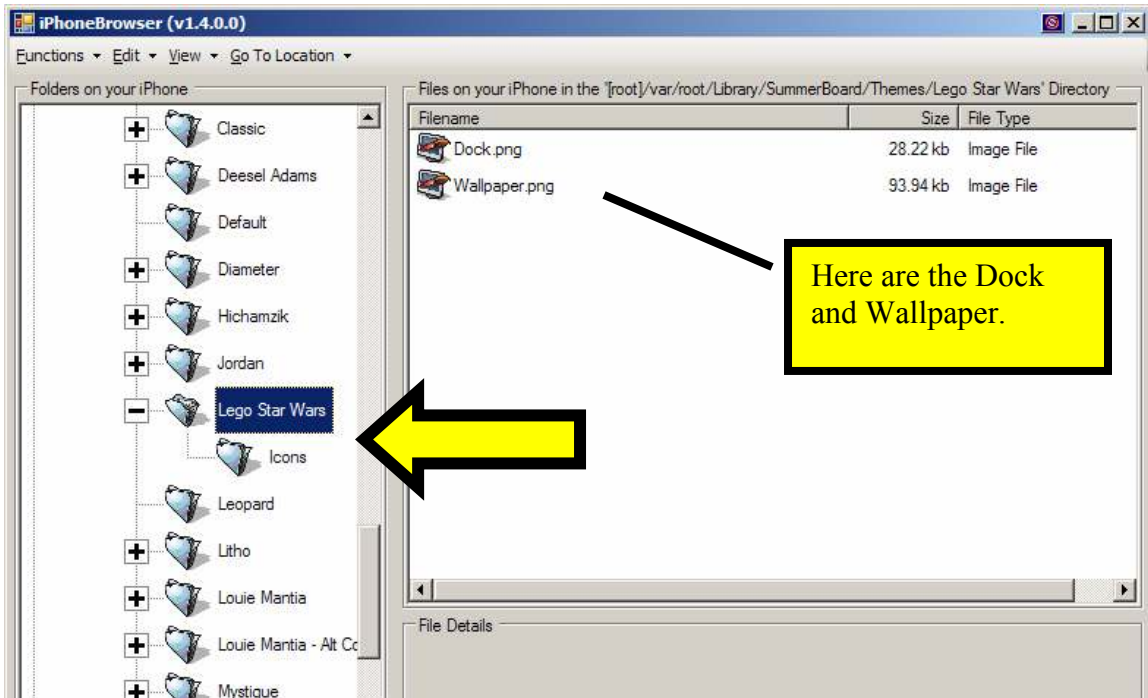
Here's the hard part....now drag and drop your theme folder from your computer into iPhoneBrowser.



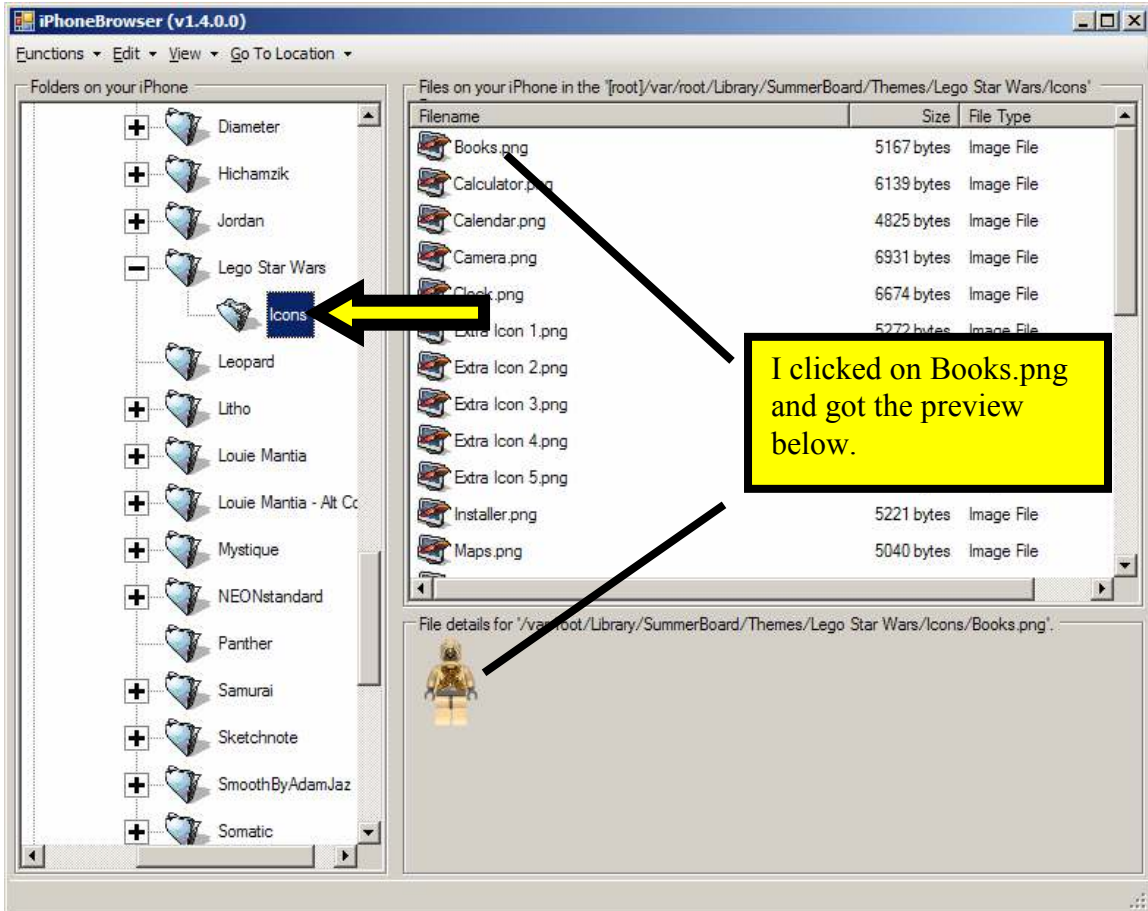
After dragging and dropping your new theme into iPhoneBrowser, it will do a quick refresh and your new theme should appear on the tree of folders.



If you click the + sign on the tree, you can see the folder setup.

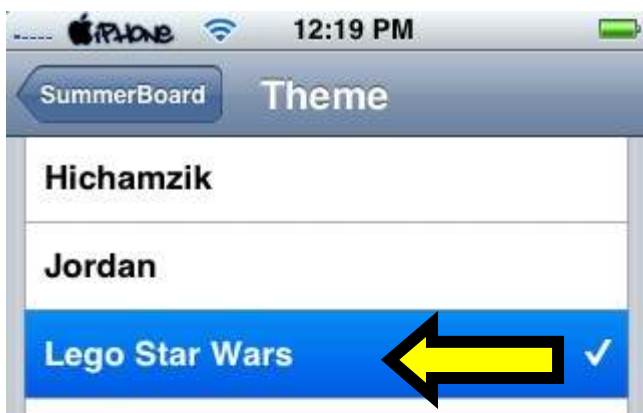


Clicking on the Icons folder, you will see all your icons with a preview. The same can be done for the Dock and Wallpaper.

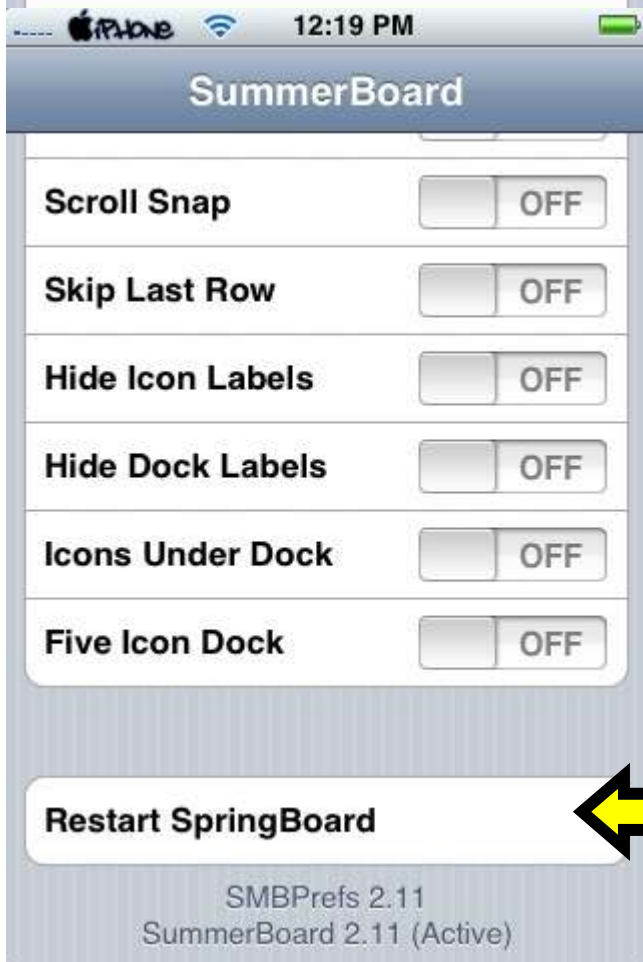




From here all you have to do is launch SummerBoard and choose Theme.



Select your newly uploaded theme.



Restart your SpringBoard and you're done.
