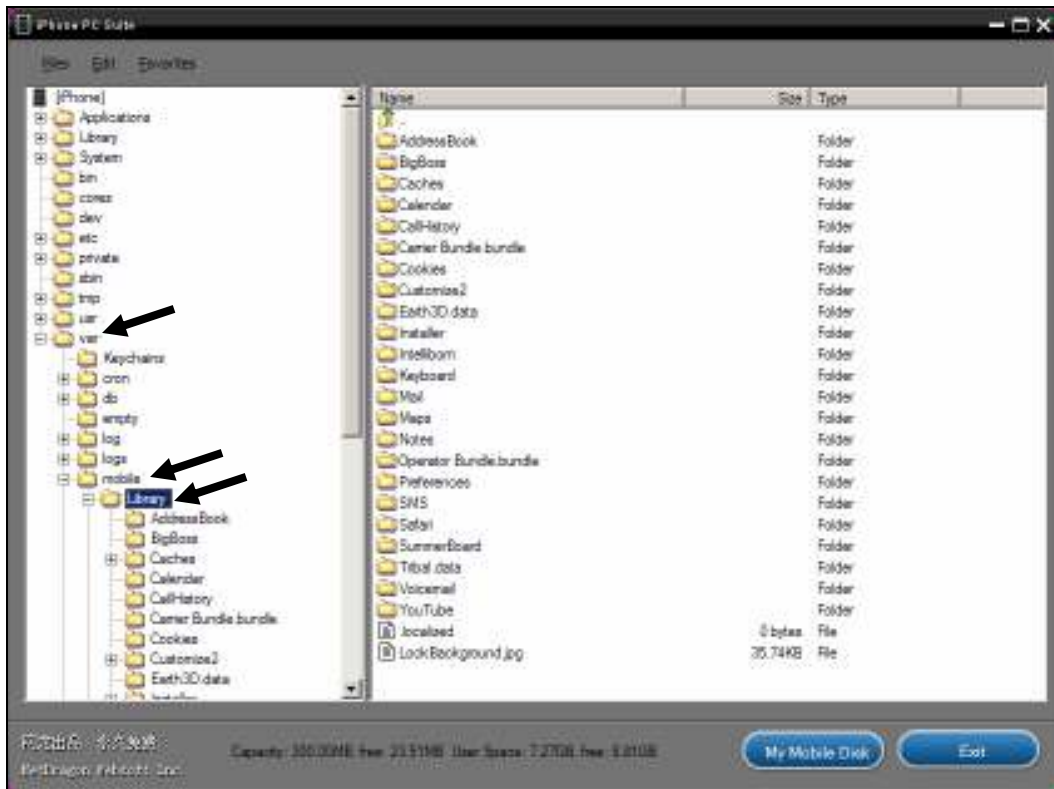
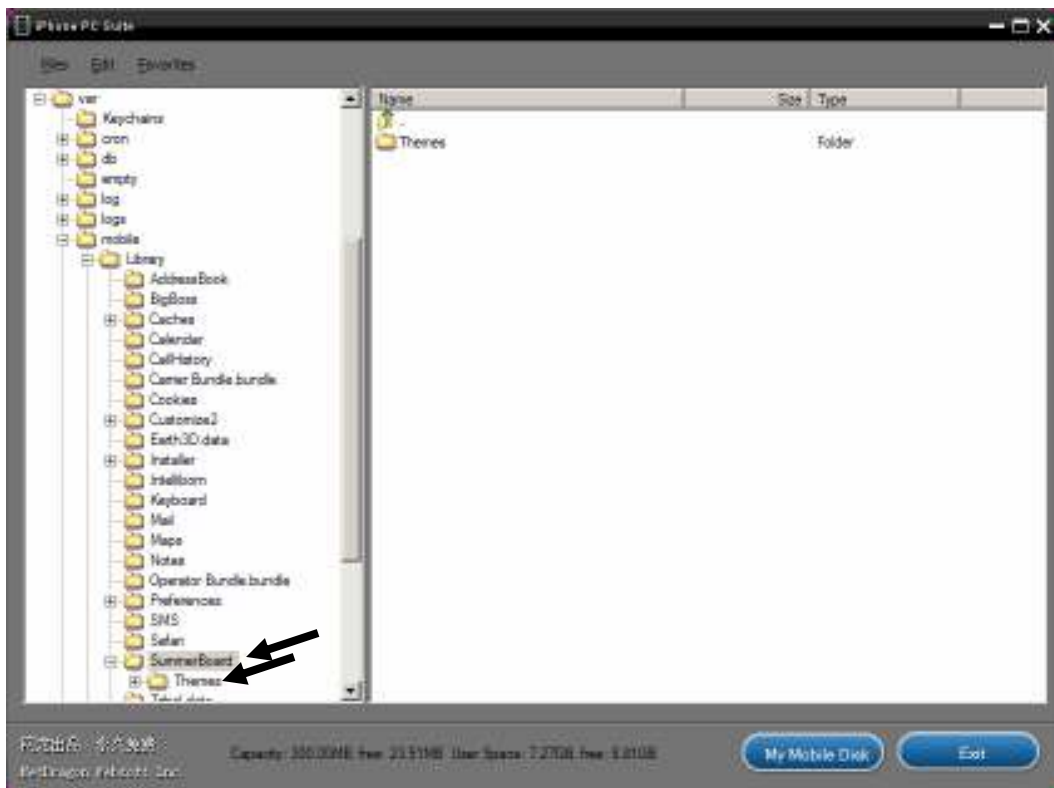


Prerequisites:

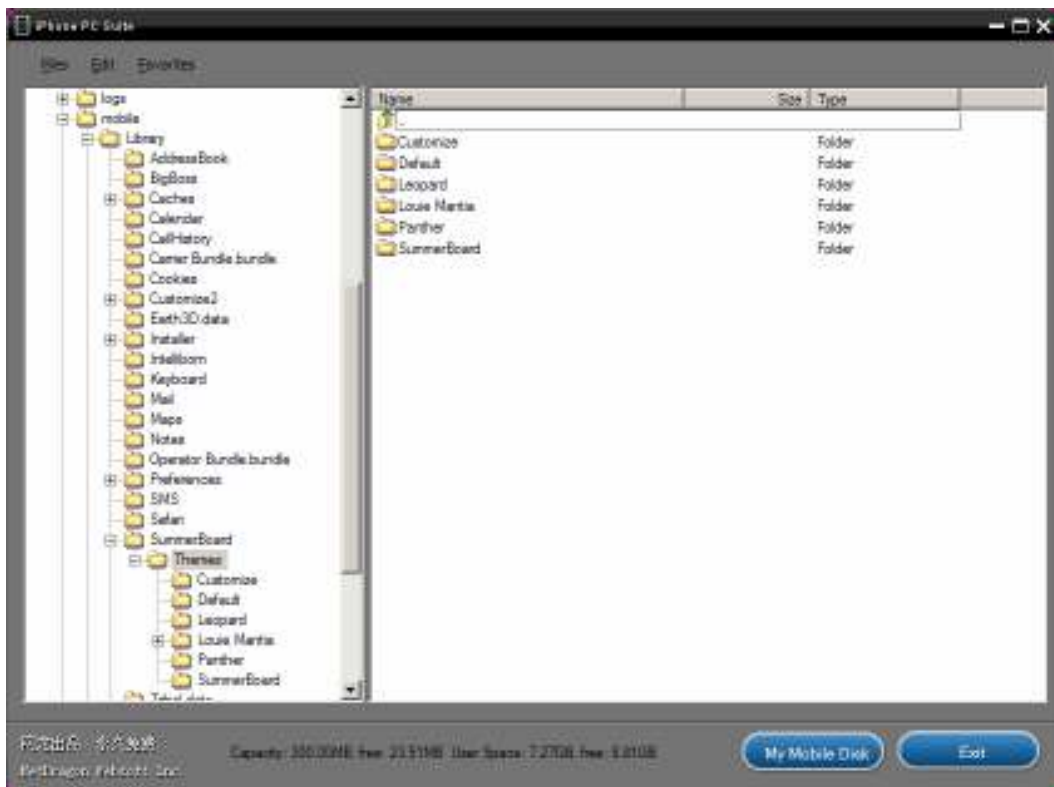
- Jailbroken iPhone
- Firmware 1.1.4 (**this may work for 1.1.2/1.1.3 but it will not for 1.1.1 and lower**)
- File browser of your choice such as:
  - iPhonebrowser (PC) – you may have to install the ‘ibrickr fix’ to use this one. Google it.
  - iPhone PC Suite (PC) – used in this tutorial.
  - iFuntastic (Mac)
  - Or whatever you currently use
- A SummerBoard theme downloaded to your computer.



Open your file browser. And go to:  
var > mobile > Library



Once inside the Library folder click on:  
SummerBoard > Themes

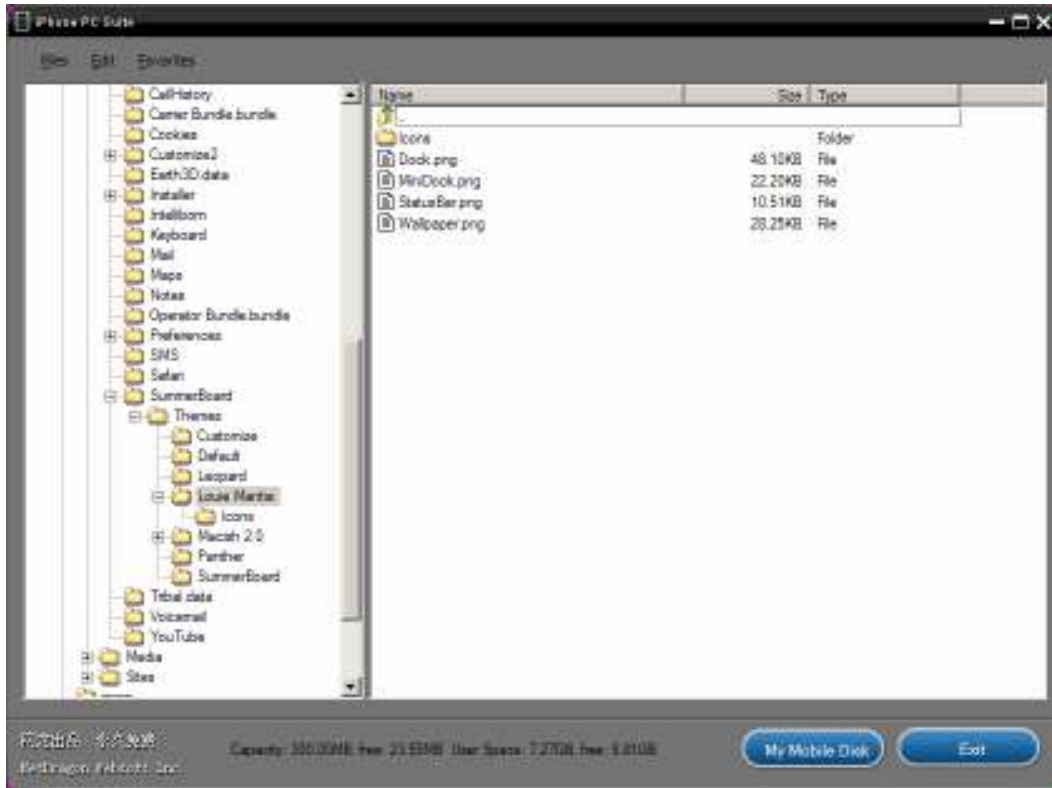


Inside the Themes folder you will see all your SummerBoard themes that you already have installed. In my case I have:

- Default (comes stock with the phone)
- Leopard
- Louie Mantia

- Panther

If you click in one of the folders you will see how the theme folder is set up.



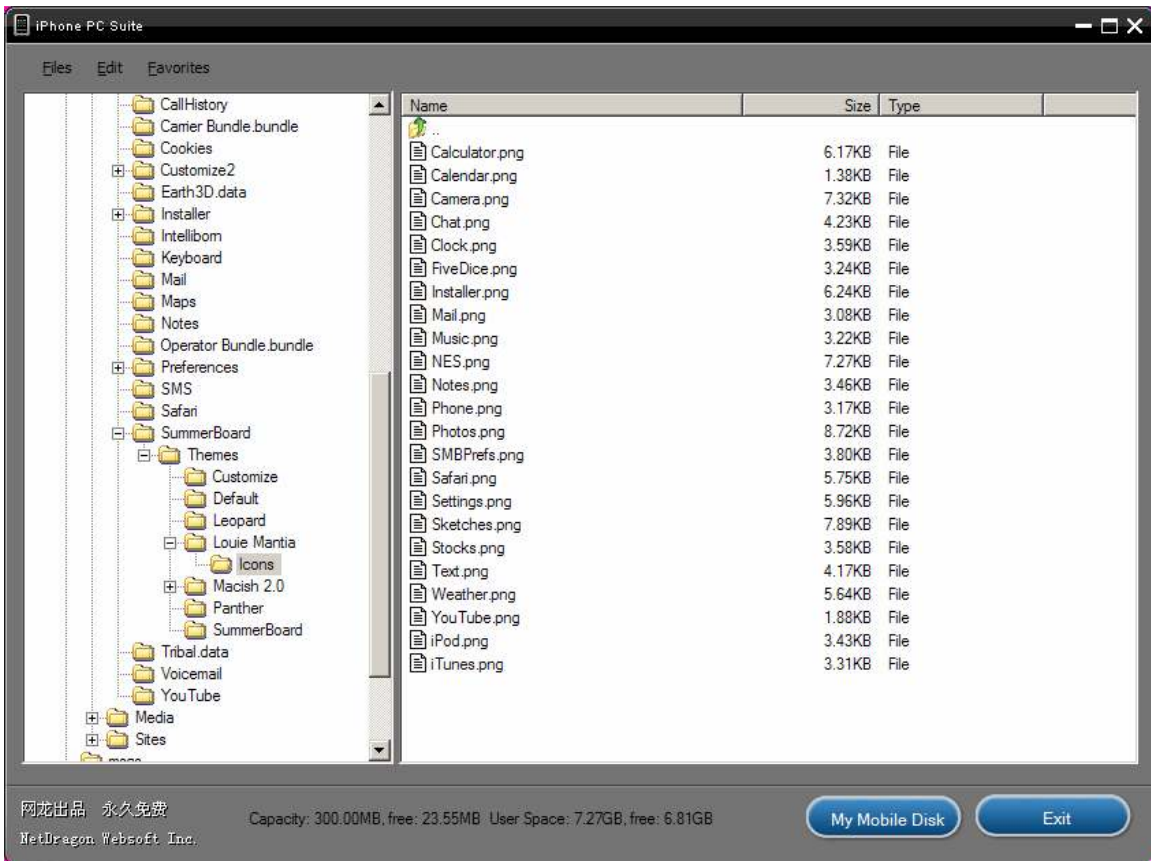
I clicked on the Louie Mantia theme and I see the layout of it. It goes:

- Theme Name (this is the main folder for your theme)
  - Dock.png (this is the theme dock image)
  - Wallpaper.png (this the theme wallpaper image)
  - Icons folder (applications icons are in this folder)
    - All the icons for your theme

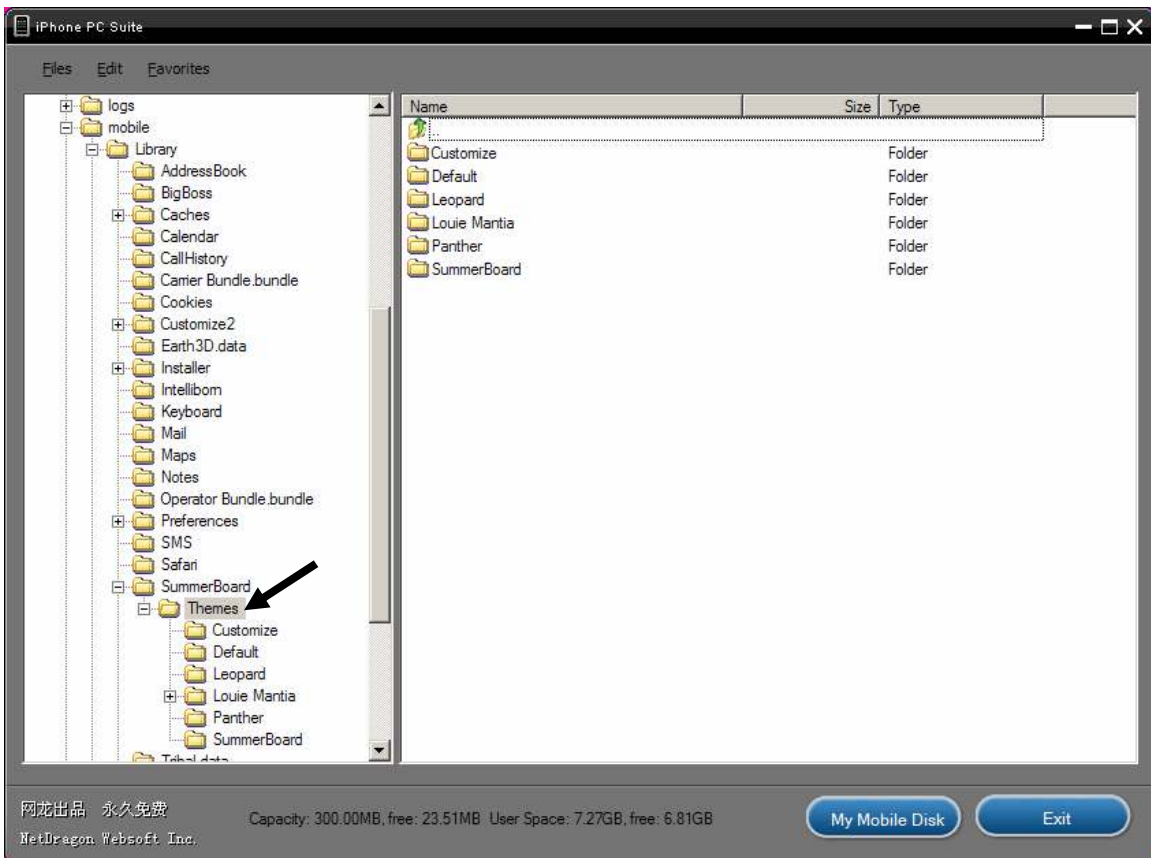
This is the general layout for a theme. You may or may not have extra files inside the theme's main folder. Some theme creators include extra docks and wallpaper.

Some things to note:

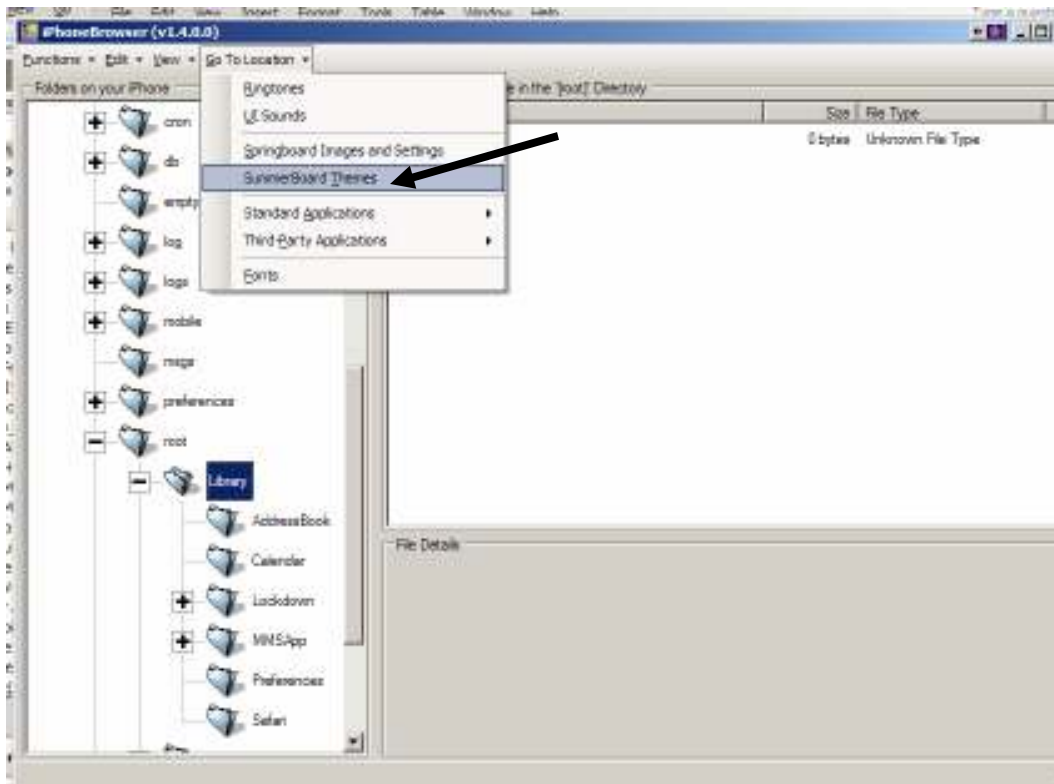
- The Icons folder must be named Icons and not icons. The 'I' is capitalized. Otherwise your icons may not work properly.
- The application icons are named exactly as they appear on your Springboard. In other words if the app is named YouTube on your Springboard you must name your icon YouTube. It can't be named Youtube or youtube or anything else.
- If an icon is shifting other icons and causing them to be out of line the problem is most likely with the application icon inside the application folder.



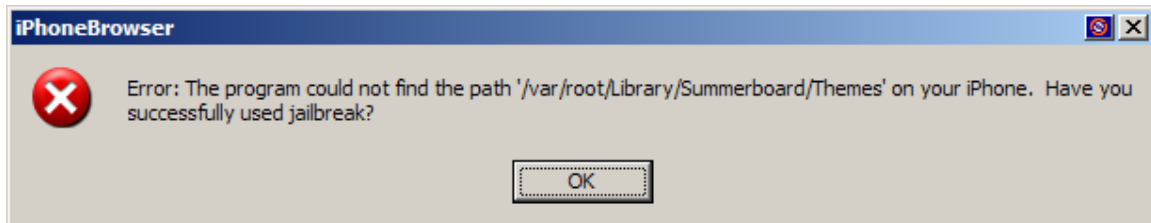
Here's a peek inside the Icons folder.



Go up a few folders until you're back in the Themes folder. From here you can drag and drop your theme directly into your file browser for the most part. I know with iPhonebrowser and iPhone PC Suite you can but I'm not sure about iFuntastic. You can't drag and drop with iBrickr so I don't recommend it.



If you use iPhonebrowser, the menu shortcut to jump to Summerboard themes will not work.



You will get this error even if you are jailbroken. So you'll have to surf to the location by clicking the folders.
